SAYING GOODBYE WHEN PEOPLE LEAVE YOUR CONGREGATION

Acknowledge my loss What have I lost through their leaving? (consider obvious things like friendship, ministry partnership, ministry work. But also not so obvious like: trust, ability to continue to open my heart, courage, etc).
How have I thanked God for their investment? Thank you, Lord, for
Thank you, Lord, for Thank you for the ways they have invested in my life and the life of the church.
Have I thanked them, personally and out loud, for their investment in us and our congregation? What is preventing me from doing this?
Have I confessed any bitterness that has resulted from their leaving? What is preventing me from taking ownership/responsibility for my own sin and confessing it? What do I hope to gain by holding on to it?
Have I badmouthed them in the presence of others? Do I need to take this before the Lord and surrender it, allowing Him to be my Defender?
Write out a "Go in peace" prayer for these believers. It may not feel 100% authentic, but sometimes as we walk in obedience, God will change our feelings towards our "enemies". Ask the Lord to give you a loving heart towards them.
